Too much marketing hype and not enough common sense! The vision suggests a new garden village (more like a town) with the capability to employ a high proportion of residents. This is rural Rutland (population at the last census c.38,000 (2011) with c.16,500 households(2016)) and the vision suggests another 3,000 households over time which at an average of 3 people per household implies an increase in population approaching 25%. This is not the outskirts of a boom town like Cambridge (you use examples of Great Kneighton and Accordia), where many new residents work in Cambridge and many commute to London. These options are not available for the residents of the proposed St. Georges development. Public transport is non existent and the probability of major employers locating on site is minimal however much the vision might wish for it. Consequently many residents will travel to Leicester, Peterborough and/or London for work putting pressure on the junctions onto the A606 from the A1 (already a dangerous bottleneck at rush hour) and more locally from Normanton Road onto the A606 near Empingham. If any part of this vision is to be realised the Highways Agency and road planners will have to be involved - perhaps upgrading the A1 from Stamford to Peterborough might help particularly when the new A14 is complete. Residents could then commute to the boom town of Cambridge - even better develop Stamford and Oakham into proper commuter stations with appropriate facilities, plenty of car and bike parking, and of course more frequent and faster trains!
